WIFI

We hope you will want to switch off during your stay and enjoy some screen-free time to enjoy the wonders of Mother Nature and the terrific array of activities available nearby, but if you would like to stay connected, or you are working remotely, wireless internet access is available throughout the premises using the following details:

DEPARTURE

On the day of departure, please be ready to check out of your room at:

Monday to Friday - 10am

Saturday to Sunday - 11am

If you would like to arrange a later check out, please speak to a member of our team and we will do our best to accommodate your request, subject to availability.

ACCESS

You are free to come and go as you please and there is a Residents' Door located at the back of the pub (at the foot of the stairs as you depart your room), should you prefer to use this entrance during your stay.

Please note, the pub staff do not remain on-site overnight, therefore, should you be planning a night out on the town (or you're an early riser and heading out for fresh air), please don't forget your room key, as this will give you access to the main Residents' Door.

ROOM FACILITIES

Want to look your best? We have ironing boards and irons located in the communal guest services cupboard, along with a hairdryer that will actually dry your hair (we all know how often this isn't the case in hotels!). Should you have forgotten any key items for a big day, do let us know and we will be happy to direct you to the closest pharmacy, convenience store or retail outlet to ensure you feel, and look, great!

REFRESHMENTS

There's nothing quite like enjoying a good cup of tea to help you settle in. Here in the room, you will find a Nespresso Coffee Machine (please refer to User Instructions located next to the machine), and Mozzo coffee capsules, alongside the kettle and a selection of Birchall tea to enjoy. Fresh cow's milk, and dairy-free alternatives can be obtained from the bar downstairs, or we have UHT milk in the room.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Odiham is a quaint market town in Hampshire, filled with history and close links to the Royal Air Force. We hope you find the following information useful to best plan your time here with us.

HIGH STREET PARKING

On-street parking is available along the breadth of the high street every day. Please be aware, between the hours of 8 am – 6 pm you can stay for a maximum limit of 2 hours without charge.

If you are arriving in the evening, you can park for free on the high street between 6 pm – 8 am. Please avoid parking directly across from the pub on a Thursday evening as a Friday Street Market is setup from here and parked cars will be blocked in (signs will be in place).

PAY & DISPLAY CAR PARKING

The Deer Park View Car Park (RG29 1JY), located just behind the pub is ideal for those who wish to park their car all day or when there are no spaces on the high street. The cost for all day parking is £4 (Mon – Sat). Free parking is available on Sundays, Bank Holidays and every day after 6pm.

The ticket machine accepts coins, card and is also linked to the parking app MiPermit. For ease, the quickest way to access the car park from the pub is to exit the Residents' Door and turn right towards the residential dwellings, keep walking and you will enter the car park (a minutes' walk).

NEAREST TRAIN STATIONS

Hook train station is 2.6 miles away and is on a direct line to Basingstoke and London Waterloo. We would recommend pre-booking a taxi to pick you up as this is a quiet station. Alternatively, you may prefer to get off at the earlier stop of Fleet train station (7.1 miles in distance from the pub), which offers a more frequent train service. Whilst Fleet station is further away, there are always taxis sitting outside.

Farnham Castle Keep

english-heritage.org.uk

Standing on the crest of a hill overlooking the town of Farnham are the impressive motte and 'shell keep' of a castle founded in 1138 by Henry of Blois, Bishop of Winchester and brother of King Stephen. The castle was rebuilt in the late 12th and early 13th centuries, but a viewing platform reveals the buried remains of an earlier tower.



Highclere Castle (Downton Abbey), Newbury

Enjoy the history, the glamour and so much more on a visit to Highclere Castle. There are between 250 and 300 rooms in the Castle and during your tour you will explore the main state rooms, so familiar from "Downton Abbey". You will see some of the bedrooms before taking the stairs down to the cellars and old staff quarters where you will find the Egyptian Exhibition, celebrating the 5th Earl of Carnarvon's discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun.

Odiham Castle, North Warnborough

Known locally as 'King John's Castle', Odiham Castle is located within a tranquil site adjacent to the Basingstoke Canal. The site has witnessed and been part of many historical events, from the signing of the Magna Carta, a French siege to the ownership of the de Montforts, a revolt and even the imprisonment of a Scottish King.



Jane Austen's House, Chawton

Feel the history as you visit the pretty Hampshire cottage that Jane Austen revised, wrote and had published all six of her treasured novels. Today you can step back in time to 1816 and follow in Jane's footsteps, see the rooms where she composed her books and created her timeless characters. Explore her home, discover objects that belonged to her and wander in the beautiful cottage garden.

Waverley Abbey

Visit the very first monastery founded in Britain by the reforming Cistercian religious order. A small group of monks from France settled in this quiet spot by the River Wey in 1128, and Waverley soon became the springboard for Cistercian settlement in southern England. The impressive remains include the fine 13th century vaulted refectory or dining hall for the lay brothers, the Cistercians' labour force.
